

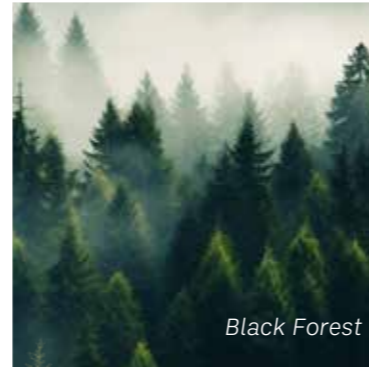

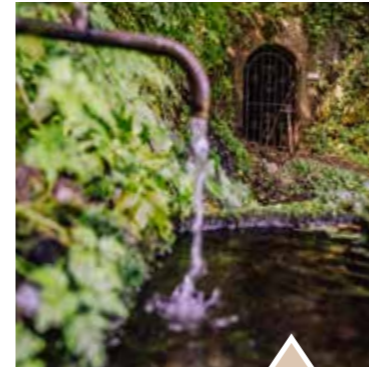



## THE REMARKABLE VALLEY

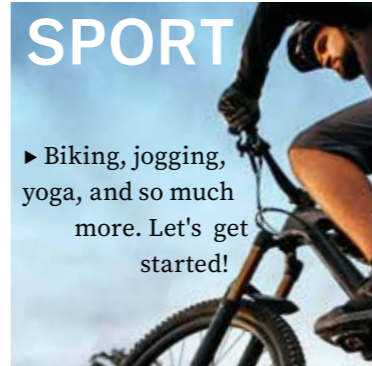

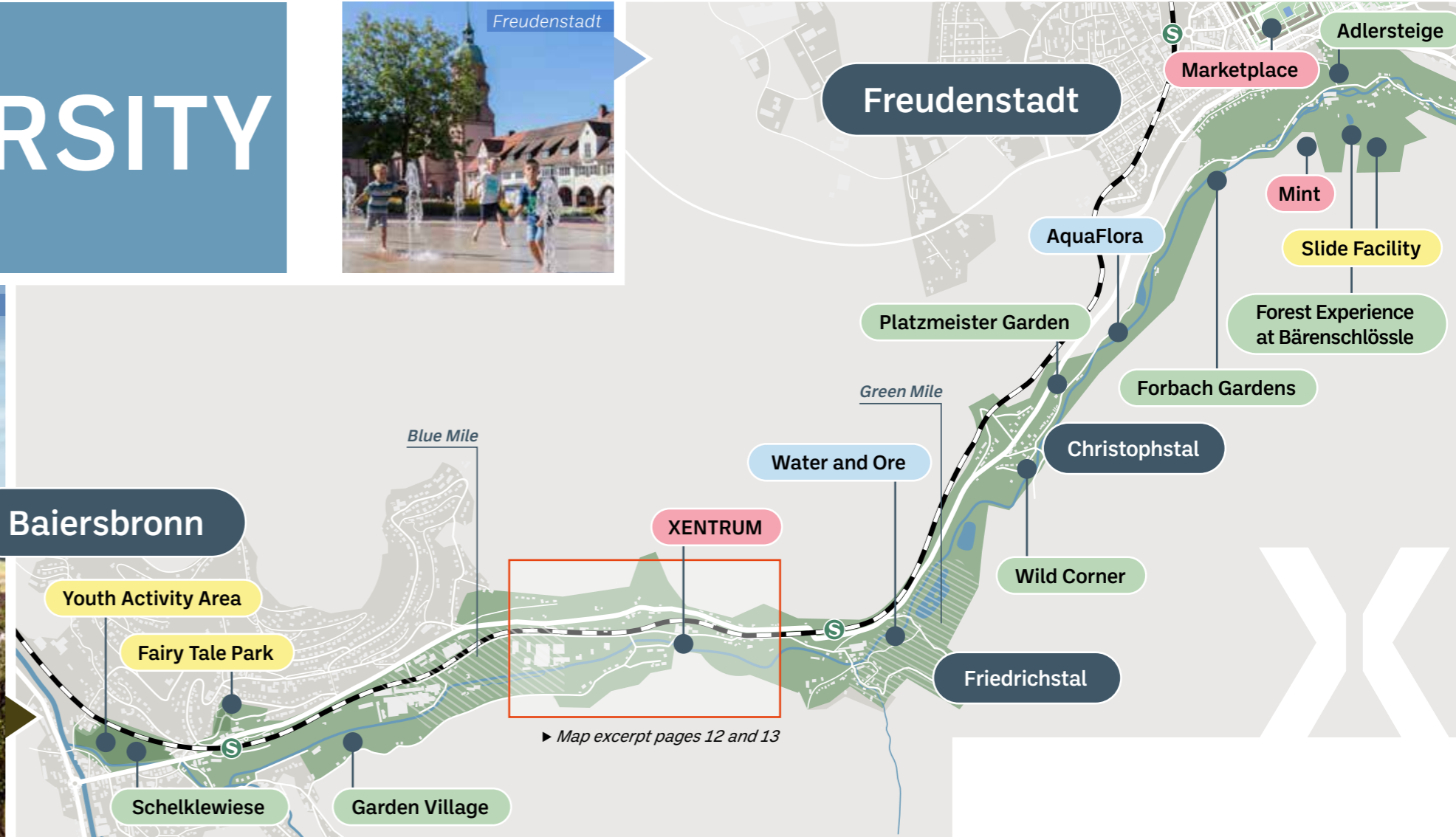

The quality of the water in the Forbach is undisputed, so it is only logical to make fish farming experiential for visitors with a display tank and to impart knowledge about aquaculture and the native trout.

## GARDEN VILLAGE

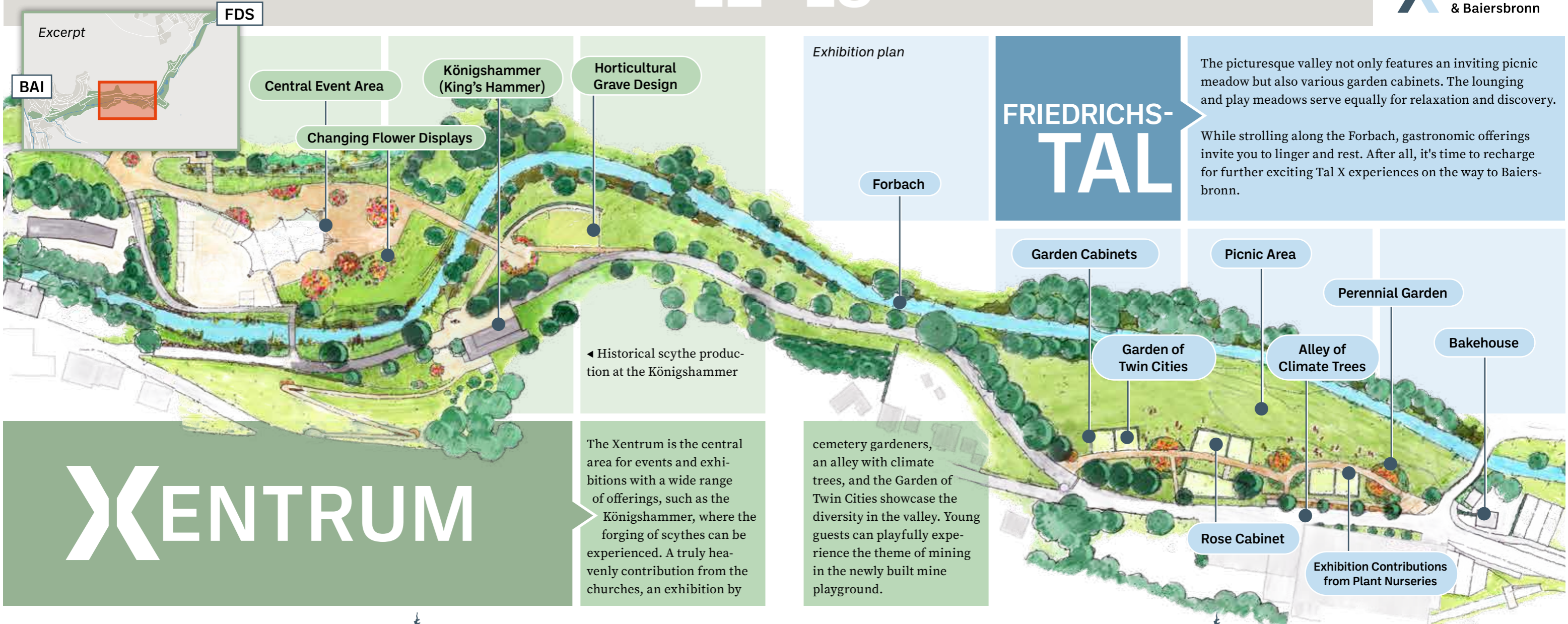
